PREFACE

Because the mission of this station requires extensive compartmentalization of operation, it was felt that the organizational method of presentation would be the best for clarity.

Components of this history have been prepared by personnel possessing the appropriate technical and operational knowledges to properly state their objectives, problems and solutions to the fullest advantage.

In resume of background: the 3084th Aviation Depot Group was activated on 1 July 1954 at Westover Air Force Base, Massachusetts. On 28 July 1954, the 3084th ADG moved from its temporary quarters on Westover AFB to its permanent location immediately adjacent to Westover AFB. Upon completion of real-estate agreements presently being coordinated between the Air Materiel Command and the Strategic Air Command, the site of the 3084th ADG will be redesignated as Stony Brook Air Force Station.

sections with delegated authority commensurate with their positions. This action had a marked reaction by improving the morale of many junior officers and non-commissioned officers who were confused and discouraged.

A series of weekly retreat parades were initiated to develop military esprit de corps among all personnel, especially the younger airmen. The program was enhanced by rotating the positions of commander of troops down to flight leaders among the appropriate ranks of officers and non-commissioned officers. The authorization of individual squadron first sergeants by higher headquarters further increased the military stability of this station.

By 1 June, the station gained the technical and military stability it had previously lacked and entered into a program of readying itself for the AMC IG inspection scheduled for August of 1955.

During the latter part of June, notification was received that the 3079th Aviation Depot Wing NCO Academy had been established at Fairfield, California. This station was allocated a quota of three applicants per class. In practical application of the NCO prestige program, the responsibility for selecting candidates was given to a committee composed of the group and squadron first sergeants. M Sgt William W Rinear, Group First Sergeant, was designated chairman of this committee. All applications were on a volunteer basis with all applicants receiving a personal interview by the committee before final selection. This method was successfully used in selecting the first three candidates to attend a class to be conducted on 10 July.


