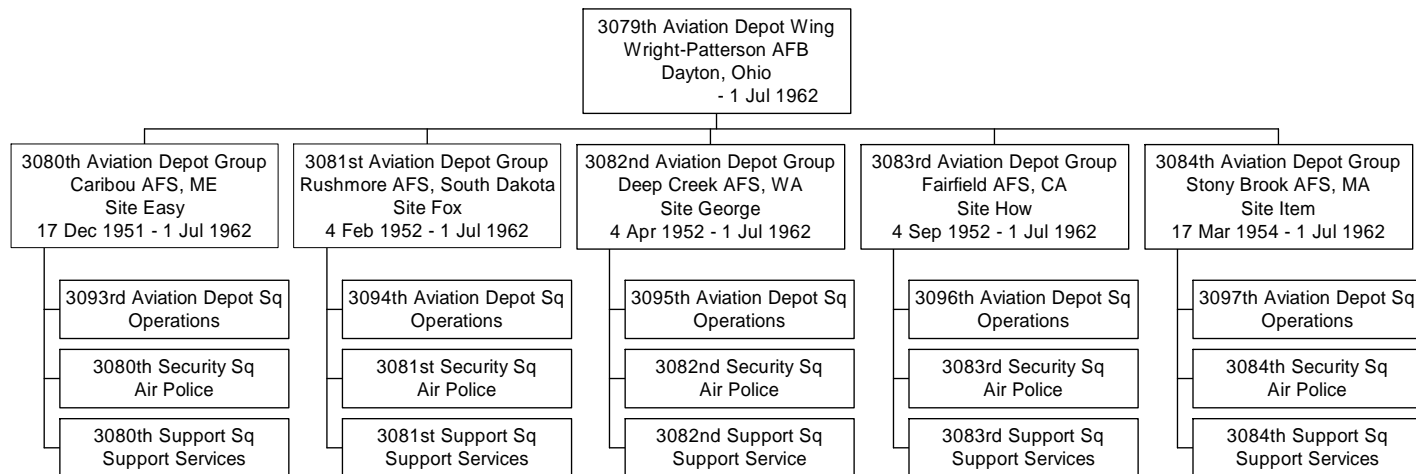

Stony Brook AFS mission transferred to Westover AFB and the 24th MMS after 1962.

The following logistic support squadrons (LSS) were also assigned to the 3079th Aviation Depot Wing. Their primary mission was the transport of nuclear weapons world-wide. They utilized the C-124 Globemaster aircraft.

Activation/Deactivation Dates

7th LSS	Robins AFB, Georgia	18 Oct 1954 to 8 Jan 1966
19th LSS	Kelly AFB, Texas	24 Sep 1952 to 22 Dec 1969
28th LSS	Hill AFB, Utah	8 Jul 1953 to 8 Apr 1969

Note: All of the Operational Storage Site facilities were transferred to Strategic Air Command on 1 Jul 1962. The Wing was disbanded on that date. The Logistic Support Squadrons, which had been activated in 1952-1954, were transferred to the Military Air Transport Service (MATS) in 1962. The LSS's continued with their mission of transporting nuclear weapons world-wide until their deactivation. After 1962 they trained the MATS crews in their main mission of weapons transport.
